

Navigation Policy

With these responsibilities in mind Quest Maritime Services has drawn up a navigation policy designed to manage, control and where possible reduce the impact of our activities. The navigation policy is based on the below points:

- All Senior Management, employees and other associated personnel shall be united in promoting safe maritime transport activities, with high priority to safety
- We shall adhere to all maritime related laws and company policies, procedures and work instructions so as to achieve a high level of compliance
- We shall constantly review and where appropriate improve our vessels safety management systems and strive constantly to improve our vessel safety standards
- We shall promote the development of human resources by providing regular maritime safety education and training for our employees and those with whom the company works
- We shall ensure all masters and crew possess certification appropriate to the duties they are expected to carry out and there certifications are current and in date.

This Policy has been reviewed and endorsed by the management of QMS who foresee benefits in, and take responsibility for, its successful implementation.
